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- Baseline water sampling required prior to first well proposed within a governmental section
 - Sample closest Laramie-Fox Hills water well within the governmental quarter section
 - Or deepest representative water well if no L-FH in $\frac{1}{4}$ section
 - Or a water well within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile if no wells can be sampled in $\frac{1}{4}$ section
 - Initial baseline testing analytes: dissolved methane and various water quality parameters
 - Additional analysis required if methane is > 2 mg/l
 - Copies of results submitted to landowner and COGCC within three months
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- Required to be submitted with Form 2A (Oil and Gas Location Assessment)
 - WMP meets general requirements of Rule 907.a
 - Obligations to ensure proper storage, handling, transportation, and treatment/recycling/disposal of waste and to meet the allowable levels in Table 910-1
 - Waste handled to protect waters of the state from significant environmental impacts
 - Reuse and recycling are encouraged
 - WMP describes type and estimated volumes of waste
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
