AS-BUILT LOCATION POLICY

(adopted September 7, 2005, amended October 31, 2005)

WHEREAS, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission has the authority to regulate the drilling, producing and plugging of wells for the production of oil and in accordance with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act §34-60-106(2)(a), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission has the authority to promulgate rules and regulations to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public in the conduct of oil and gas operations in accordance with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act §34-60-106(11), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission has promulgated Rule 303.c. which requires a scaled drawing of the proposed well locations with certain data; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2005, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission amended Rule 303.c. to require latitude and longitude coordinates of proposed well locations using the North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) with an accuracy of at least five (5) decimal places; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission deems it important that accurate locations for all existing well locations not plugged and abandoned be reported.

NOW THEREFORE, after due consideration:

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission hereby requires that for existing drilled well locations not plugged and abandoned, all operators shall submit prior to plugging and abandonment but no later than five (5) years from the effective date of this policy the latitude and longitude coordinates in decimal degrees with an accuracy and precision of at least five (5) decimals of a degree using the NAD 83 datum (e.g.; latitude 37.12345 N, longitude 104.45632 W).
