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Air Monitoring Plans

COGCC and APCD are reviewing Regulation 7 Air Monitoring Plans for Oil and Gas Locations.

Locations being reviewed by both agencies:

- In areas with greater number of Residential Building Units or High Occupancy
 Building Units within 2,000 feet of the Oil and Gas Location;
- Condition of Approval on existing Location Form 2A;
- Local Government or other Agency request; or
- Higher profile locations.

Operator Considerations

The COGCC encourages Operators to consider developing an air monitoring and sampling program for all Oil and Gas locations that satisfies COGCC's need for air monitoring to protect nearby receptors and CDPHE's emissions monitoring requirements.

Considerations may include:

- Placement of Air Monitors in relation to Residential Building Units or High Occupancy Building Units
- Type of Monitors used and what analytes are being Monitored. Total VOC or more specific such as Benzene.
- Action Levels and what action will be taken. Consider which agencies will be notified.
