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Form 2C - new question #1

Rule 303.d.(1).A sets the duration of the public comment period for the entire OGDG based on the siting of each Location:

- 30 days from completeness determination
- 45 days from completeness for OGDGs that have any Locations within 2,000' of a Residential BU, HOBUs, or School within a DI Community
