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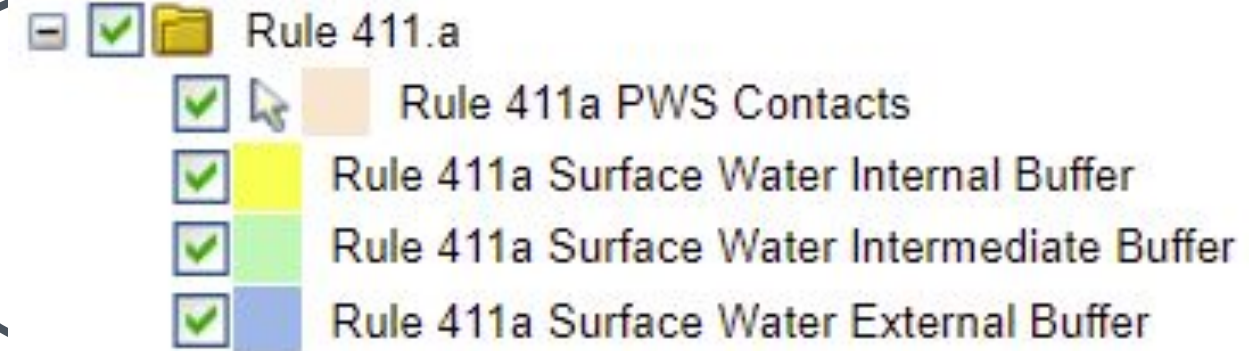
General Information

- Map layers are a guidance only, and all PWS locations and buffer zones must be confirmed
 - Field measurements will carry the day
- Map layers are visible at zoom ratios less than 1:250,000
- PWS Contact info is made available from CDPHE, if found to be incorrect, contact the Source Water Protection Program at WQCD
- Definition in Rule 411.a.(1)
- Buffer Zones defined in Rule 411.a.(1)B

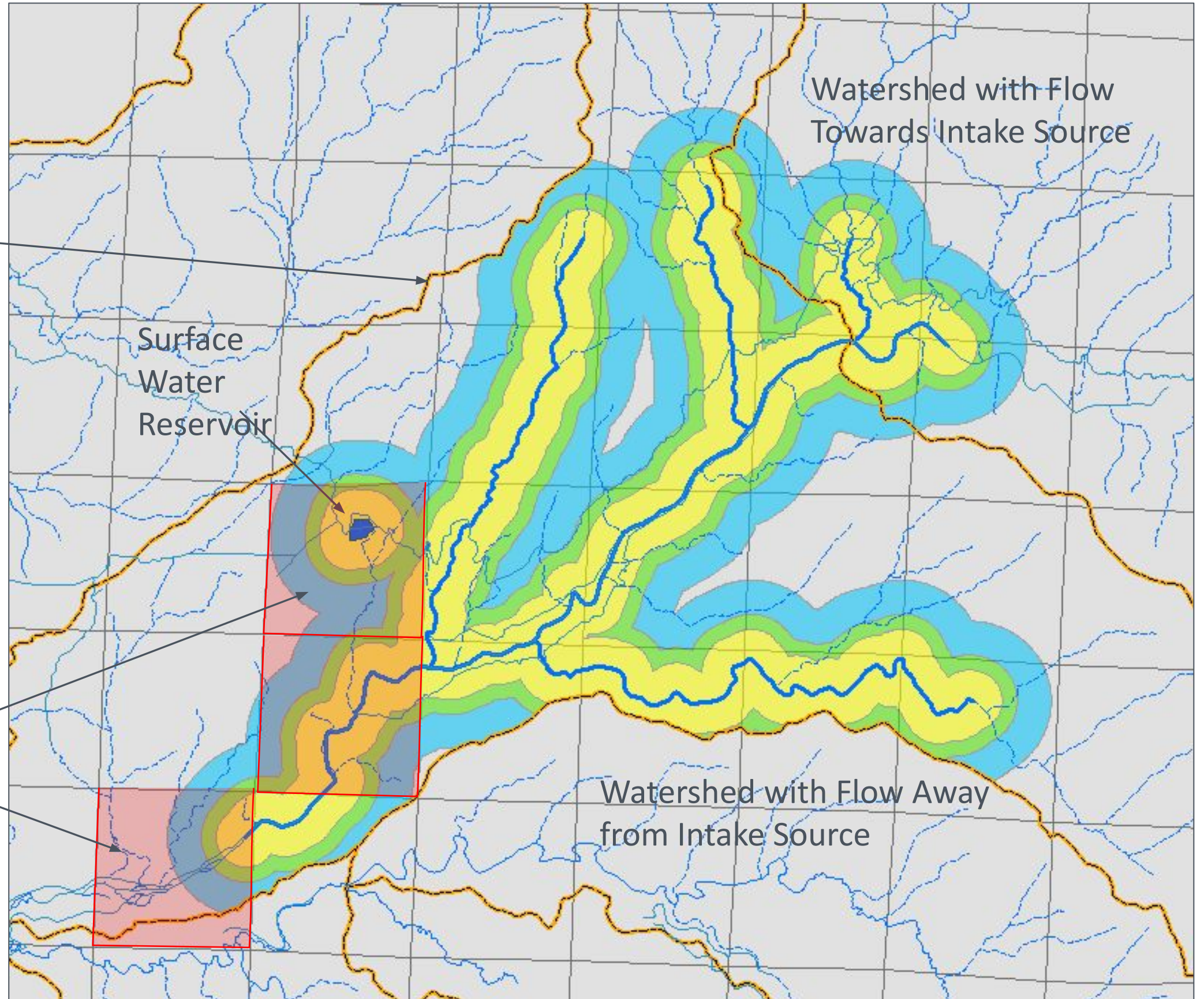
